Værnes-ekspressen - Unibuss (the easiest way...)

Værnes Ekspressen - Unibuss Ekspress Direct route between Trondheim city center and Værnes, only 25 minutes from Solsiden to Værnes. Stops right outside the door at most hotels in Trondheim City Center. Others in short walking distance.
